SPEAKERS

Gunter PAULI - Economist - (BELGIUM)

Gunter Pauli was the visionary founder, in 1994, of the ZERI foundation (Zero Emission Research and Initiatives), created after three years of research on the economic model of the future. It is based in the Blue Economy, an economic model that shows how to make more with what is locally available, in order to offer beneficial products and services for health and the environment, cheaper than the market standards, and aimed at stimulating the entrepreneurial spirit to create jobs while respecting Nature.

Luc SCHUITEN - Biomimicry architecte - (BELGIUM)

Regarded as a visionary architect, he believes that we have forgotten a little too quickly that we are primarily bilogical beings nestled in a living planet. What will our future look like? In response to this question, he imagines new living areas, conceived from the observation of vast ecosystems such as coral reefs or primary forests. Through different futuristic perspectives, evolving over time, a coherent and poetic world, linked to the imaginary, is progressively built. He suggests solutions fro tomorrow's public and individual tranportation, he proposes archiborescent habitat forms, immediately feasible and studies the cities of Lyon, Bruxelles, and São Paulo in the year 2100. These visions of a positive future are the result of a new relationship between man and his natural environment. Luc Schuiten has chosen to communicate his original concepts through pictorial expression because it allows to effectively make people enter his imagination. These original representations of a sustainable future are well supported by the close collaboration he has with the biologists deom the Biomimicry Europa.association.

Dan WINTER - Physicist - (USA)

He is considered one of the most dynamic thinkers of our time, a world expert in implosion phenomena in Physics and Psychophysiology, physicist, author, inventor, authority in the field of Sacred Geometry and in the scientific description of Consciousness. He is at the forefront of science and, with his teachings, he inspires everyone to reconsider their belief systems. He constantly formulates revolutionary ideas on the profound unity of things and our «unity» via sacred geometry, architecture, art, mathematics, biology, computer science and mythology. His theories have laid the foundation for a new research in the USA.

Callum COATS - Naturalist - Architect - (AUSTRALIA)

A naturalist and architect, Callum Coats has spent twenty years translating, gathering and composing books, articles and letters by Viktor Schauberger. The result was presented in his book Living Energies. He is also the translator and editor-in-chief of four volumes on Eco-technology that encompass a broad spectrum of Schauberger's work: The Water Wizard, Nature as Teacher, The Fertile Earth and The Energy Evolution.

James OSCHMAN - Researcher - (USA)

Pioneer in the exploration of the scientific basis for alternative medicine. He has both the academic credentials and the background in alternative medicine to carry out his explorations. He has published over 100 articles in academic and complementary medicine journals. He lectures widely on the biophysical and quantum phenomena occurring in therapeutic situations.

Audun MYSKJA - M.D. - (NORWAY)

Since the 1970s, he has worked in neurological musical therapy and developed integrative medicine, the influence of musical frequencies on health.

Amit GOSWAMI - Physicist - (INDIA)

As a physicist, he studies cosmology and quantum mechanics in order to investigate the limits between mind and body, looking to unite spirituality and physics. Founder of the Quantum Activism movement that seeks to give people the ability to transform the world in accordance with the principles of quantum physics, based on ethical values, intuition and creativity.

THINKTANKS SHOWROOMS ARTS

Ana BRANCO - Artist - Researcher - (BRAZIL)

Developed for a number of years at the Open Study, Research and Design Group of the Pontifical Catholic University of Rio de Janeiro, BIOCHIP is a research on living nutrition that she transmits through her environmental education actions.

Laymert GARCIA DOS SANTOS - Sociologist - (BRAZIL)

From a sociologist's background, he develops transcultural experimentations with Yanomami shamans, on resonances between contemporary Western technology and the ancestral technical devices they use. An excerpt of the experimental film "Xapiri" directed by Leandro Lima, Gisela Motta, Laymert Garcia dos Santos, Stella Senra and Bruce Albert will be presented. It is an experimental film on Yanomami shamanism, produced during two shaman meetings in the Watoriki village, in the Amazonas state, in March 2011 and April 2012. The film was conceived in order to take into account two different notions of image: the Yanomami's and ours.

Mamadou TOURÉ - Financial Expert - (CAMEROON)

Founder of Africa 2.0 and promoter of the Vision Africa 2020 Manifesto. He works at IFC (International Finance Corporation, World Bank Group) in Johannesburg, in charge of private sector investments in telecommunications, media and technologies spanning Subsaharian Africa.

Thierry KELLER - Polytechnician - Musician - Inventor - (FRANCE) A specialist of water energetics, he has assembled the works of Nikola Tesla, Viktor Schauberger and Marcel Violet in order to create magnetic vortexes capable to vitalize water.

Luc LABAT - Architect and Researcher - (FRANCE)

After studying architecture at the School of Fine Arts in Toulouse, he turns to ecological architecture and discovers Chinese energetics and geo-biology, which quickly became his passion. His career also evolved after encountering the concept from the «Theory of Shapes and Fields of Coherence».

Alain BESSON - Musician and Choirmaster - (SWITZERLAND)

Alain Besson is a music and piano teacher, a choirmaster and maestro. His book «Au Commencement était la Musique» (In the Beginning, there was Music) received the Prix Giraud. Living in Canada, he has toured 7000 km around Québec with pianist Marc VELLA and also performed at the Cirque du Soleil in Montréal. He teaches the Yoga of Sound.

Jean-Paul BIBÉRIAN - Electronics and nuclear physics engineer - (FRANCE)

Jean-Paul Biberian is an electronics and nuclear physics engineer, holds a PhD in physics and is a physics Associate Professor at the University of Aix-Marseille. He has, for the most part, worked on the physics and chemistry of materials' surfaces. For the past 19 years, he's been working in the controversial domains of cold fusion and biological transmutations.

Pier RUBESA - Musician - Researcher - (CANADA)

Concert pianist turned music composer, sound engineer then independent researcher fascinated by the universe of sound and music. He created a recording and analyzing system for bioactive signals: the Bioscope, through which he develops a concept of sound treatment: the audiovitality system.

Louis BEC - Artist - Researcher - (FRANCE)

Artist, professor, biologist, researcher in the field of artificial life and 3D technologies. He created the Scientific Institute for Paranatural Research in which he develops a fabulatory epistemology in Technozoosemiology.
